Update to Durable Medical Equipment (DME) Client Signature Waived During COVID-19 – Texas Medicaid

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The [Texas Health and Human Services Commission \(HHSC\)](#) is extending the signature requirement waiver for the Durable Medical Equipment (DME) Certification and Receipt Form through **December 31, 2021**..

Are client signatures required for DME during COVID-19?

No, client signatures are not required for DME Certification and Receipt Form through December 31, 2021.

New Information

Beginning with dates of services on or after **January 1, 2022**, this **COVID-19 flexibility will end**, and the client or guardian signature requirement for DME Certification and Receipt Form will resume. Continue to watch HHSC for updates.
